


YHWH told Moshe to take a census of all the males twenty vears and older. There were forty-six thousand, five hundred in the tribe of Reuven. The tribe of Shimon had fifty-nine thousand, three hundred, and the tribe of Gad, had forty-five thousand, six hundred and fifty. Yehudah had seventy-four thousand, six hundred. The tribe of Yissachar had fifty-four thousand, four hundred males over twenty years old. The tribe of Zevulun had fifty-seven thousand, four hundred. The tribe of Ephraim had forty thousand, five hundred, and the tribe of Manasseh had thirty-two thousand, two hundred. The tribe of Benyamin had thirty-five thousand, four hundred, the tribe of Dan had sixty-two thousand, seven hundred, and the tribe of The tribe of Asher had forty-one thousand, five hundred. Naphtali had fifty-three thousand, four hundred. The total number of males twenty years and over, of all the tribes except the tribe of Levi, was six hundred and three thousand, five hundred and fifty.


The tribe of Levi was counted differently. Every male from one month old and up was counted. There were twenty-two thousand, three hundred.

After that, they took a census of all the firstborn males of the Children of Yisrael. There were twenty-two thousand, two hundred and seventy-three. There were twenty-two thousand non-firstborn males in the tribe of Levi for a difference of two hundred seventy three firstborn males who had to pay a redemption price because there were not enough Levites to redeem all the rest of the first born of Israel.





Cut out the cards, mix them up, then try to put them in the proper order without looking at this page.








