(conceived seed)

When a woman conceives and bears a male child, then she will be unclean for seven days. On the eighth day then the child's father is supposed to circumcise his son. Then the woman will continue in her uncleanness for thirty-three more days, for a total of forty days.

When a woman conceives and bears a female child, then she will be unclean for fourteen days, as in the days of her regular monthly cycle. Then after that she will continue in her uncleanness for sixty-six days, for a total of eighty days.

After the woman has completed her days of uncleanness, whether it is forty days for a male child or eighty days for a female child, then she is to bring a sacrifice to YHWH. She is to bring a lamb for a burnt offering and a dove for a sin offering. However, if she is too poor and cannot afford to bring a lamb for a burnt offering, then she may bring two doves. She is to bring one dove for a burnt offering and another dove for a sin offering.

After she offers to YHWH this commanded sacrifice, then she shall be clean.

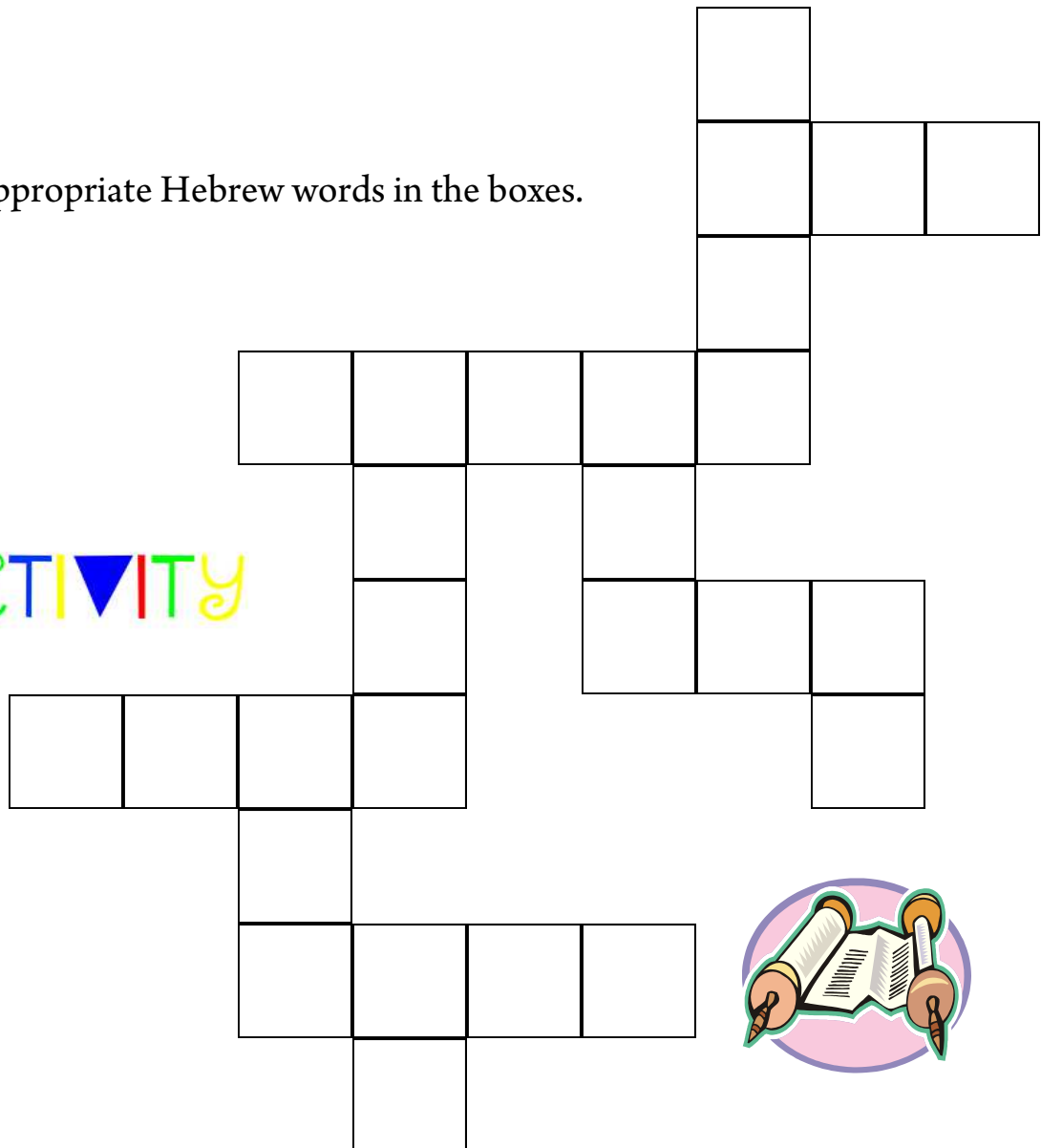
